Graffiti is a quality of life issue. The presence of graffiti contributes to a general sense of squalor and a heightened fear of crime. The key to eliminating graffiti is enforcement and quick abatement. Remove graffiti from your property as soon as possible. Vandals want recognition of their work and removing it will discourage them from our corridor. Property owners who do not remove graffiti in a timely manner are subject to fines.
